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### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

## 1. Standing Transfer

The TURN-TABLE can be used either independently by the client or with assistance by one or two nursing/care staff.

# 1.1 Independent Transfer

The client places the TURN-TABLE on the floor in front of their seated position. The client then places both feet on the TURN-TABLE and transfers to an alternative seated position such as a wheelchair/bed or commode, using a transfer board or their own upper body strength to complete their manoeuvre.

#### 1.2 Assisted Transfer

As above however the client is helped to a standing position using an approved manual handling technique and is rotated on the TURN-TABLE by one or both of the carers to an alternative seated position.

#### 2. Seated Transfer

The soft surface and flexible design of the TURN-TABLE allows clients to sit on the TURN-TABLE and rotate themselves either on a bed or chair as well as in and out of a car seat.

# CARE AND USE

Be vigilant check device integrity before use.

Upper surface of the TURN-TABLE may be washed with warm soapy water or brushed with a stiff brush to remove dirt.

The base of the TURN-TABLE may be washed with warm soapy water.

### NOTE

Always ensure that the carer/nurse anchors the turntable with their foot whilst carrying out the transfer to prevent any lateral movement of the disc.
